

Kentucky Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board  
Meeting Summary  
December 13, 2004

At the December 13, 2004 public meeting of the Kentucky Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board, held at 1:00 p.m. E.T. in Frankfort at the Frankfort Convention Center, the following action was taken:

Chairman Anderson announced the resignation of Board member Ms. Jan Tronzo;

New Department of Labor senior staff were introduced;

New Board member Mr. Don Earl Goodman was introduced and sworn in;

Approval of the May 4, 2004 minutes;

Adoption of the amendment to 29 CFR Part 1910, Subpart T, Commercial Diving Operations, as published in the February 17, 2004 Federal Register, permitting recreational diving instructors and diving guides to use alternatives to an on-site decompression chamber;

Adoption of the amendments to 29 CFR 1910.103, 1910.217, 1910.219, 1910.268, and 1910.307, as published in the June 8, 2004 Federal Register, correcting technical errors;

Adoption of the amendment to 29 CFR 1910.134, Respiratory Protection, as published in the August 4, 2004 Federal Register, approving the REDON fit testing protocol; and,

Adoption of the amendment to 29 CFR Part 1915, Occupational Safety and Health Standards for Shipyard Employment, as published in the September 15, 2004 Federal Register, promulgating a fire protection standard for shipyard employment.
